



I Am New...so what do I do?

Welcome to **KidMin** at Central College Presbyterian Church (CCPC)! We are so eager to meet you as you and your family. Below is a brief overview of things that are helpful to you during your visit to Central College Presbyterian Church (CCPC).

9:30 a.m. Worship Hour

1. From the Christian Education tab to the **KidMin** page of the website, (if you're reading this, you've found us!) fill out and then print the **First Time Registration Form and Parent Authorization and Photo Forms**. Bring them with you to CCPC. It's a time-saver but no worries if you forget! We have extras.
2. If it's your first Sunday morning visit, we suggest arriving 20 or so minutes before the scheduled worship service and **parking in the North lot** as it is the best location until you become better acquainted with the location of things.
3. Enter the main building through the **WELCOME CENTER** doors that are clearly marked and can be seen from the North parking lot. If you don't enter this way, just ask someone to guide you to the Welcome Center.
4. In the **WELCOME CENTER**, you will see a **Computer Kiosk** and a greeter to help with check-in of your children. If you brought the completed forms with you, you may hand them off to the greeter. After you are all checked in, the greeter will also direct you to the ministry locations which are applicable to you and your children.
 - The Sanctuary, for traditional worship
 - Kirk Hall, for contemporary worship
 - The Nursery, room 112 in the Academy hall for children ages 0-24 months
 - Club Toddler, room 102 in the Preschool hall for children 2 years – 3 ½ years
 - Preschool/Kindergarten Children's Worship in LL-19, under Ballard Hall, for children 3 ½ years through Kindergarten
 - Elementary Kidz Church in the Children's Church Activity Area for children 1st-5th grades
5. Following check-in, all children go directly to their designated Children's Ministry room, as listed above.
6. If you need a restroom or a quick snack or beverage up in Ballard Hall, they can direct you there too! Please make yourself at home in our church!
7. **SAFETY – Checking in your child is important** as reports are printed and provided to Small Group leaders and Sunday school teacher so that attendance can be verified. (It's part of our safety policy).
8. **SAFETY** - Adults working with minors have had instruction in our CCPC "Children and Youth Protection Policy" and background checks. We staff each room with 2 adult leaders or a minimum of 1 adult leader and another serving as supervised access—floating between 2 or more rooms throughout the ministry time. (A copy of our safety policy can be provided to you. Please ask for it by contacting Judi Irwin, Director of Children's Ministries at judi.irwin@ccpc.us)

11:00 a.m. Worship hour

Please follow steps #1-#4 above. Children birth through 3 ½ years are welcome in Room 112 for Nursery care. Children 3 ½ years and up are welcome in the Sanctuary to worship with their family. Worship Activity Bags are available from a greeter at the door of the Sanctuary. Please ask! Another option is available in Ballard Hall. We offer closed circuit viewing of our traditional worship in an informal atmosphere with snacks and beverages awaiting your enjoyment! Quiet activities are available for you in a cabinet under the screen in Ballard Hall.
